Like everyone along the Gulf Coast, we are monitoring the clean-up of the Deepwater Horizon oil spill and relying on official updates from the Unified Command response team and local emergency management officials for information.

Tuesday, June 8, 2010

As of this morning, there were reports of oil impact on our beaches in varying degrees. We have teams in place to clean up the affected areas. A swim advisory is still in effect but the beaches are OPEN. With that in mind there is still much to do in our area such as hitting the links, shopping at the outlet center, dining in one of the area's finest restaurants, or just relaxing by the pool.

Regarding the clean up of the beaches, the cities of Gulf Shores & Orange Beach have persuaded BP to purchase ten additional beach raking machines. These machines will make the clean up quicker and more effective as they are capable of sifting even very small contaminants from the sand.
